More information regarding scholarships

The Folke Bernadotte Academy (FBA) may award scholarships to a selected number of participants who do not have the means to pay the course fee. An important criteria for selection is that the course applicant is deemed relevant for the course, in the sense that s/he would both benefit from and be able to contribute to a course.

The FBA's resources for scholarships are limited. Scholarships generally only cover a certain percentage of the course fee. Please be aware that when you apply for a scholarship, your course application is processed separately. Hence, applying for a scholarship may reduce your likelihood of being admitted to the course.

In order to assess your application for a specific course properly, please attach a copy of your CV to your web application and write a short explanation in the motivation field including:

- How will you benefit from the course? (how do you foresee to use what you learn in the course)
- What will you be able to contribute to the course?
- Why are you seeking a scholarship?

Should you be admitted to the course, we will ask you to submit a letter from your organisation/employer confirming that you have been granted leave for the duration of the course.
